It is the responsibility of the Bidder to verify that their Bid Proposal and all addenda has been received and delivered to the VCCCD Purchasing Department prior to the bid opening date and time. Verification of receipt can be obtained through the listed Purchasing Specialist.

Jobwalk of 6/9/21 - Questions Asked and Answered:

1. Final questions are due on Wednesday, June 16, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. All questions are to be submitted to jonellmiller@vcccd.edu. They will then be sent to the Architect, Director of Facilities and Janice Kisch for a response.
2. The Bid Opening is Wednesday, June 30th at 3:00 p.m. at the District office in Camarillo as listed on www.vcccd.edu.
3. Bid Documents can be downloaded from our website <https://purchasing.vcccd.edu/>. Go to Bids and Agreements. Choose Current, then open Bid 620.
4. This project is being award by Base Bid as listed in listed in **Section 00210 Bid Proposal**.
5. Substantial Completion is 120 Consecutive Calendar Days as found in **Section 00800 Special Conditions 1.01 Contract Time A**. Additional information specifically pertaining to this bid is also listed in Section 00800, so be sure to read through this section thoroughly.
6. Submittals – Contractor may begin preparing submittals immediately upon award of Contract. All submittals must be complete and submitted for approval within 30 calendar days of the Notice to Proceed.
7. It is the Contractor’s responsibility to haul away all debris.
8. The existing sign is to be demolished and hauled away by the Contractor.

9. Partial walls are to be removed while others areas of the wall remain as listed in the specification.
10. A laydown area on campus will be set up with the awarded Contractor. An encroachment permit will be required by the City of Moorpark, if the project impacts traffic or the street. While fencing is not required, we do require the contractor to make the space “safe”, and the contractor is responsible for the security of their materials and equipment.
11. While some electrical power is available some is not, therefore the Contractor will be responsible for getting the power needed. Electrical is noted in the plans.
12. Placement location for a rollaway lockbox will be made available on campus for this project.
13. Most trees remain. Others may have to be removed, as defined in the plans. Follow the site plans for the landscape and demolition.
14. The plans calls for Fiber Optics. Cellular is not acceptable for this project. The plans call for LED or equal. The AV Section is included in the Bid Package and listed as a section after the “Technical Specifications” at the end of the Bid Document Binder as posted.
15. In regards to the LED and audio visual display board, the manufacturer noted is DigiLED. Their HQ is in England. Is there someone the architect has been in contact here in the United States with to request information?
