SUBJECT: Addendum 1 – Bid 662, Moorpark College Aviary Improvement Project

The bid opening remains on **Thursday**, **November 30th**, **2023**. Bids must be received no later than **3:00 p.m**. at 761 E Daily Drive, Suite 200, Camarillo, CA 93010. Properly mark the outside of the exterior envelope on your submitted bid with the <u>Bid Number and Name</u> according to the requirements stated in the bid packet directions.

If you choose not to participate in this particular bid, please sign the Bid Proposal stating "no bid" and email or fax it back to me at 805-652-7700.

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to verify that their proposal has been received by the VCCCD Purchasing Department prior to the opening date. Verification of receipt can be made through the listed Purchasing Specialist.

The following information is in answer to questions that were asked at the job walk and via email request. The deadline for questions was Monday November 20th, 2023. No further questions will be accepted.

- 1) Is there existing wiring where the existing receptacles are?
 - a) Yes.
- 2) What is the amperage of the new outlets? 15 amps? 20 amps?
 - a) Minimum amperage is 20 amps.
- 3) Are we using existing wire? (Is there wiring already?)
 - a) Connect to existing wiring at existing outlets on site, must run wire and conduit to new locations with two gang waterproof outlet receptacles.
- 4) Are we allowed to turn off and lock out tag out circuit feeding the plugs?
 - a) Yes.
- 5) How far is the nearest power source?



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- a) On Site.
- 6) Are we using existing bell boxes?
 - a) No, transition to underground box.
- 7) Are the cages to be provided by Campus or will the Contractor need to provide them?
 - a) Campus will provide cages, Contractor is to install.
- 8) For construction note #28 Install above ground electrical outlet, are we connecting to an existing electrical conduit?
 - a) Connect to underground conduit, provide conduit and wiring to outlets at new locations.
- 9) Please provide details for fence post footing and etails for installation of bird cages.
 - a) For the fence post, we propose the post be placed in concrete 12-inch diameter by 18 inches deep. For the installation of the bird cages, the cages are already built. Contractor is to move cages into concrete curbs, set on curbs, and bolt to concrete.
- 10) Will there be colored concrete?
 - a) Yes, tan concrete.
- 11) Is the walkway to be a mix of concrete and brick?
 - a) Yes, the walkway will be a mix of concrete and brick.
- 12) Is there to be new fencing?
 - a) Yes, and is to match existing fencing.
- 13) Is this a DSA job?
 - a) No.
- 14) What vehicle access will we have?
 - a) Two means of entry. Through the front gate of the zoo and through a back gate that is accessible through the parking lot from the baseball field.
